

TOURNAMENT DETAILS

- Only visually challenged players verified by AICFB are allow to participate in the ICMB.
- Sixteen players will be selected from each zonal championship conducted by AICFB in 2024. However, if any of the top 4 players from the previous AICFB National Chess Championship belong to a specific zone, the number of available spots for that zone will be reduced accordingly. This ensures balanced representation across zones while honoring the achievements of top-performing players.

Notes

- Two Players from each zonal final will be selected to play SOG GrandMasters Series Nationals.
- During Zonal Finals, a player is forbidden to carry a mobile phone and/or any other electronic devices (including all type of wrist watch) in the playing venue in his pocket/body. If it is evident that a player had such a device during the game in his pocket even in switch off mode or battery removed, he/she shall lose the game. The opponent shall win. No bags will be allowed inside the tournament hall.
- Indian Chess Masters for Blind is a free registration tournament.
 No registration fees will be applicable.
